Face Bingo


Level: beginner, intermediate, advanced **Goal:** to explore and learn about feelings and emotions **Materials needed:** Bingo Face page and Expressions pages

Activity:

- Give each student a copy of each page
- Use the Facial Expressions page as a foundation for discussing each feeling
- Cut apart the 7 face cards and 2 free cards and glue them on the Bingo Face page- Students should glue their faces in different squares from their neighbor. (be sure you have your own set of the 7 face cards cut apart)
- Place your face cards in a container and draw one at a time.
- Students cover up the feeling drawn on their cards.
- Vary the game by having the students give an example of when they felt each card is drawn.

Follow up suggestions:

- Instead of stating the expression on the card try these options:
 - State a situation you might be in to feel/look this way. Ex: I lost my bike.
 - o Make the expression and the students guess.
 - o Describe the facial features such as; the eyes, eyebrows, mouth



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
